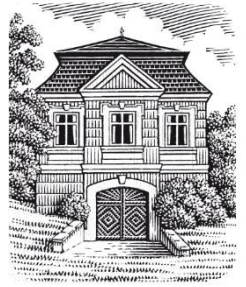

Our Gaisberg vineyard is located at the plateau of Gaisberg hill, which is oriented to the south and is sheltered by Manhartsberg hill towards the north. The soil boasts weathered conglomerates like schist and gneiss. This vineyard undergoes big temperature differences due to its fairly high geographical location and the mighty conifers on Manhartsberg hill – both of great advantage for very aromatic wines.
