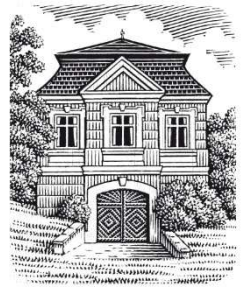

The single vineyard "Stein" is the easternmost located vineyard in the Kamptal area and borders directly to the Wagram. The deep reaching loess soil in combination with the south directed slope creates a Grüner Veltliner which is powerful and elegant at the same time.
