Placher vineyard: sandy gravel soil

Stangl vineyard: sandy loess

What these vineyards have in common are two things: They lie 290 m (950 ft) above sea level and have perfect conditions for Riesling wines with a clear character. Gaisberg stands for pronounced mineral tones, Placher for a crispy acidity and Stangl for density and elegance. When vinified together
